BELIZE NON-IMMIGRANT VISA INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Belize welcomes visitors and for this reason every effort is made to keep immigration formalities to a minimum. Please read the information provided on this information sheet and answer all the pertinent questions on the application form.
2. All visitors must travel on an unexpired passport, the validity must be for at least six months longer than the intended period of stay.
3. British Subjects, Commonwealth citizens (with the temporary exception of nationals of India, Sri Lanka, Pakistan and Bangladesh), citizens of the U.S.A., The European Community (twelve countries), citizens of Costa Rica, Guatemala, Finland, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Mexico, Norway, Panama, Uruguay and Venezuela **DO NOT NEED A VISA**.
4. All citizens of other countries not listed above at no. 3 require a visa. Some visas require approval from Belize and in these cases allow three to five weeks for the application to be processed; for all other applications, allow ten working days for processing. Please ensure that a passport will not be required during this period.
5. All visitors are advised to have sufficient funds for the purpose and period of their stay. The sum of fifty (£50.00) is considered a sufficient minimum daily requirement per person. This amount would include hotel accommodation, transport and meals. All visitors must be in possession of a valid return or onward ticket. Evidence in support of both funds and travel arrangements must be presented with application for visa.
6. A visa is only valid for the purpose it was originally issued. A visa does not guarantee entry into Belize. The Immigration Official at the point of entry determines whether or not a person qualifies for admission. Visitors are therefore advised to carry with them documentation provided to obtain the visa and present such evidence to the Immigration Official should it be required.
7. The visa validity period pertains only to the period during which it may be used for an application for admission into Belize. The actual period of stay is determined by the Immigration Official at the point of entry. Extensions to the period of stay must be applied for at the nearest Immigration Office in Belize. Negligence of this rule is a serious offence under the laws of Belize.
8. The holder of a non-immigrant visa is prohibited from employment of any kind.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. A separate application is required for each traveller regardless of age. Each application should be legibly printed, signed and dated. A recent photograph (1.5" x 1.5") with the applicant's signature on the reverse side should be fastened to the application form in the space provided.
2. A fee of twenty pounds (£20.00) for a single entry visa or thirty pounds (£30.00) for a multiple entry visa is charged (add two pounds (£2.00) if application is done by mail). Payment should be by a Postal Money Order or Bank Draft made out to The Belize High Commission. Cash should not be sent by mail. Personal cheques are **NOT ACCEPTED**. Please note that we do not accept responsibility for any financial or documentary loss associated with the application for a visa.
3. Completed application forms with supporting documents, corresponding passports and payment of the appropriate fee should be lodged in person or sent in by mail to the address below; however an interview may be necessary and an appointment could be made.
